CREATING AUTHENTIC COMMUNITIES OF PRACTITIONERS

Learning Communities are the primary tool that Catalyse Change Australia use to help Christian leaders put Discipleship and Mission at the centre of everything they do.

A Learning Community invites you to engage with the word, works and way of Jesus while discovering the principles of going from having a ministry to leading a movement: reproducing disciples instead of just recruiting more volunteers, multiplying communities instead of just adding more people. During the two year track you will progress from discipleship to mission, from the singular to the movemental, through a series of four three-day onsite training events (immersion experiences).

Together with your team, you will experience proven vehicles for discipleship and mission (like Huddle and Missional Community), evaluate your current realities, and look to where God is calling your Church.

Costings:

\$150 per person, per immersion
\$150 for six months of fortnightly coaching for ministry team leaders

Building a Discipling Culture

If you make disciples you always get the Church, but if you focus on making the Church, you rarely get disciples. Discipleship is the 'operating system', the foundation, the engine that makes everything else work and is therefore foundational to the future work you will do in multiplying leaders, mobilising mission and cultivating a movement.

Developing a Missional Disciple-Making Strategy

Jesus cultivated a movement of disciple making. His example and teaching in the Gospels informs a strategic process for disciple-making that identifies five phases - connecting, following, equipping, training and sending/multiplying.

Leading Missional Communities

Discipleship and mission go hand-in-hand, so as you are discipling leaders, mobilizing and equipping them to live missionally is a key competency. Missional Communities (MCs) are a vehicle for training people to live together on mission every day, mobilising the Church to live out her calling.

Multiplying Missional Leaders

The key to movemental breakthrough is not only creating disciples, but in creating disciples that create disciples that create disciples (and so on), which means that disciples need to become leaders.
